World Mental Health Day



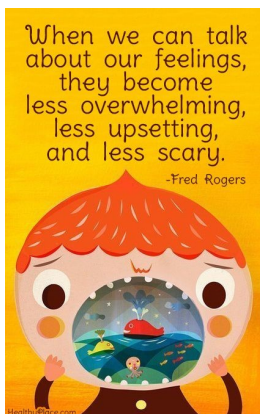
Thursday 10th October is World Mental Health Day.
