Free School Meals

From this week the pupils and families that are entitled to benefits-related free school meals will receive a £15 supermarket voucher per child.

All the parents/carers currently eligible for free school meals will have received this information and will either receive their e'voucher or collect it from our school as arranged from today.

If you think you could be eligible for free school meals, please

ensure you complete the forms and make the most of the support the government is offering at this difficult time.

Your claim for free school meals will automatically processed if you receive Housing Benefit or Council Tax Support and get any of the qualifying benefits.

Your child is eligible for free school meals if you get one or more of the following benefits:

*universal credit (provided you have an annual net income of no more than £7,400,)

*Income Support

*Income based Jobseekers Allowance

*Income related Employment Support Allowance

*The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit

*Child Tax Credit as long as you have a yearly household income of less than £16,190 and do not get Working Tax Credit
