Re-opening school

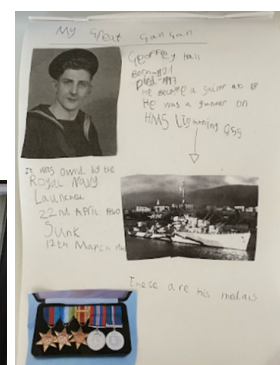
We are sure that many of you will have watched the Prime Minister's address to the nation last night.

The Government believes we may be in a position to implement a phased re-opening of schools from 1st June, starting with the pupils in Foundation 2, Year 1 and Year 6. This is part of the plan that will be kept under regular review.

As a school, like you, we have only just seen the announcement and that at this stage we are unable to answer all the questions you may have. We are waiting to receive further information and guidance from the DfE (Department for Education). As soon as we have received the additional guidance we can begin to consider what we need to do as a trust/school to re-open safely.

In the short term, nothing has changed and we will provide further information in the coming days/week once we are able to do so.

However, we assure you that whatever decisions are made for our school we will have everyone's safety at the forefront of our minds.
