In order to ensure the safety of all our school community and that we don't have to close our school or any bubbles, we firmly request that:

- Only one parent comes in the school ground to reduce the footfall in and out of the school grounds.
 - That everyone walks on the left hand side of the paths in single file especially on the foster road path where people are walking in both directions.
 - Everyone queues in a socially distanced line to drop off and collect their children from all classrooms.
 - Resources brought into school are kept to the absolute minimum to reduce contacts (lunchboxes and water bottles).
- No big bags are brought to school.
- Everyone is punctual and adheres to each classes start and finish times.
 - Reading books can be taken home but will then need to be quarantined before going back on the shelves for someone else to take home which may mean at times we have no books left of the correct level.
