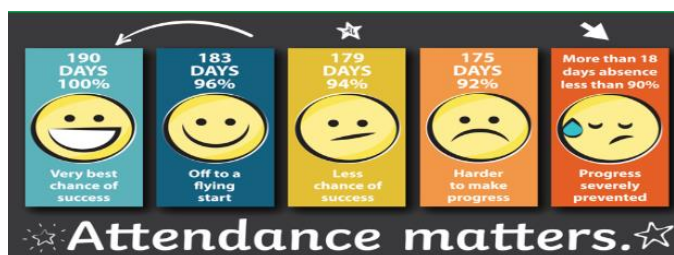

- Visit [tickets.clubdoncaster.co.uk](https://tickets.clubdoncaster.co.uk) and register (or sign in if you have purchased tickets from Club Doncaster before).
- Once signed in, click DRFC, then home match tickets.
- The England V Italy game should appear at the top, click Add
- On the next screen click on the block of where you want to sit and then choose your individual seats (most tickets at the side of the pitch have now gone, so it will be corners of stadium and behind the goal that shows most availability). #Select ticket type for each seat (eg adult, senior, 13 & under) and click add to basket when complete
- At the bottom of the next screen at the prompt coupon enter the code

(this will change the price from all 13 and under tickets from £1 to £0).
- Complete the purchase by entering chosen method of tickets and payment details.
