### **Looking Ahead**

With Christmas on the horizon, and no doubt lots of new technological gifts on their way, we just wanted to take this opportunity to remind all parents that mobile phones and smart watches are not to be used during the school day.

We absolutely understand that some children bring their phones/smart watches with them for security reasons when they walk alone, and that many smart watches provide GPS tracking capabilities to give you peace of mind, but when children arrive at school, both of these devices should be handed in to class teachers for safe storage throughout the day.

If children want to wear a watch during the school day, we ask that it is a normal watch and does not possess smart capabilities, even if features are disabled (in the same way that we wouldn't allow children to keep their phones in their possession in flight mode).
