Rewards Update!

As part of ongoing work since we asked for parent feedback last half term, revolving around the way the we reward children and ensure consistency across school, I am excited to share some changes!

As of this week, children will be able to earn some new, very special awards/certificates in recognition of their efforts.

As currently, children will still be able to earn special mentions (with a very special new certificate!) but there are now new head teachers awards when children are selected to show me excellent work, smiley postcards and lanyards which children can earn.





Postcards

Teachers give children lanyards to wear for the day where they have produced incredible work. Children get to wear this all day and will be recognised by staff wherever they go!

Children are given postcards from leaders or teachers to recognise exceptional behaviour or effort against the 5b's.

Children are very excited to earn our new rewards and our staff can't wait to spot children trying their absolute best as we continue to strive for excellence in behaviour and learning at Wickersley Northfield.

Those classes which don't currently use Class Dojo are busy setting this up for their class, so that by the end of the half term, all children have the opportunity to earn points when they show one of our 5 B's too.

Next half term, we'll take this even further by deciding on rewards which can be earnt for hitting 30 points, 50 points, 100 points etc. The school council will be involved in choosing the rewards children receive for this. We'll also look at how ALL of our staff can award Dojo points, not just classroom based staff. Lots still to come!
